Subject: MTTB Fatality Update

Date: October 22, 2008

As you are aware, there was a fatal MTTB accident in February 2008. At that time, CPS recommended that all military tandem tethered bundle operations be suspended until a complete investigation and equipment evaluation could be accomplished.

Testing and evaluation of all parachute system components and tandem tethered bundle systems have now been completed by the equipment manufacturers.

As a result of these findings, users of the **Butler "Smart Chute" TTB Systems** are cleared to put their equipment back into active service as of this date.

Strong Enterprises has issued **Product Service Bulletin #30** requesting all of their MTTB Systems be returned for modification. This PSB is available on our website under "Strong" documents in the "Tech Support" area of our site.
